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- 1. If the bidder is a Micro or Small Enterprise as per latest definitions under MSME rules, the bidder shall be exempted from the requirement of "Bidder Turnover" criteria and "Experience Criteria" subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. If the bidder is OEM of the offered products, it would be exempted from the "OEM Average Turnover" criteria also subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. - 4. Purchase preference will be given to MSEs having valid Udyam Registration and whose credentials are validated online through Udyam Registration portal as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail themselves of the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer / OEM of the offered product on GeM. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises and hence resellers offering products manufactured by some other OEM are not eligible for any purchase preference. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. 1. Generic

OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity by up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. Bidders are bound to accept the orders accordingly.

2. Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC

- 2. At the time of submitting the offer, bidder has to submit the sealed and signed bid docume nt as an unconditional acceptance of all terms and conditions as mentioned in bid.
- 3. The bidder firm should meet following eligibility criteria to qualify:
 - A. Experience & past performance: The Bidder shall be manufacturer that has regularly for at least last three years manufactured, supplied erected, commissioned screw compress or with the same or higher specifications of at least one number in last 5 years ending on 3 1st March 2023. At least 01 number of the product offered for supply should be successful operation for at least one year on the date of bid opening.
 - B. Capability, equipment and manufacturing facilities: The Bidder must have an annual capacity to Manufacture and supply at least 01 no. of screw Compressor.
 - C. Financial standing:
 - (i) The Average Annual Turnover of the Bidder firm during last three years ending on 31st March 2023 should be more than Rs. 2501616.
 - (ii) The net worth of the bidder firm should:
 - a) Not be negative on 31st March 2023 and
 - b) Not have eroded by more than 30% in the last three years, ending on 31st March 2023.

(Bidder may participate with manufacturing authorization form issued by manufacturer of the quoted product).

Note:

- 1. Participating bidder needs to submit all related documents along with the bid.
- 2. MSEs and Startups (registered for tendered item) are exempted from eligibility criteria 3 (a) & 3 (c) "Experience and Past performance" and all financial criteria as above under "MSME/registered under startup campaign scheme".
- 4. Applicability to 'Make in India' :Bidders (manufacturer or principal of au

thorized representative) If the product is being manufactured in India under a license from a foreign manufacturer who holds intellectual property rights and where there is a technol ogy collaboration agreement/ transfer of technology agreement for indigenous manufactur e of a product developed abroad with clear phased increase in local content, and who whil e meeting all other criteria above, except for any or more of sub-criteria in Experience and Past Performance above, would also be considered to be qualified provided: i) their foreign manufacturer who holds intellectual property rights, meets all the criteria above without e xemption, and ii) the Bidder submits appropriate documentary proof for technology collabo ration agreement/ transfer of technology agreement for indigenous manufacture of a prod uct developed abroad with clear phased increase in local content. Iii) the bidder (manufact urer or principal of authorized representative) furnishes along with the bid a legally enforce able undertaking jointly executed by himself and such foreign Manufacturer for satisfactor y manufacture, Supply (and erection, commissioning if applicable) and performance of 'Scr ew Air Compressor' offered including all warranty obligations as per the general and special conditions of contract.

- 5. **For Authorized Representatives:** Bids of bidders quoting as authorized r epresentative of a principal manufacturer would also be considered to be qualified, provide d: i) their principal manufacturer meets all the criteria above without exemption, and ii) the principal manufacturer furnishes a legally enforceable tender-specific authorization in the prescribed form assuring full guarantee and warranty obligations as per the general and special conditions of contract; and iii) the bidder himself should have been associated, as a uthorized representative of the same or other Principal Manufacturer for same set of services as in present bid (supply, installation, satisfactorily commissioning, after sales service a s the case may be) for same or similar 'Screw Air Compressor' for past three years ending on '31st March 2023'.
- **6. For Existing successful Past Suppliers:** In case the bidder (manufact urer or principal of authorized representative) who is a successful past supplier of Screw air compressor in at least one of the recent past three procurements (within SPMCIL/ BRBNM PL/BNPMIPL), who do not meet any or more of requirements above, would also be considered to be qualified in view of their proven credentials, for the maximum quantity supplied by him in such recent past to any units of SPMCIL.
- **7. Joint Ventures and Holding Companies:** Credentials of the partners of Joint ventures cannot (repeat cannot) be clubbed for the purpose of compliance of PQC in supply of Goods/Equipment, and each partner must comply with all the PQC criteria independently. However, for the purpose of qualifying the Financial Standing Criteria, the Financial Standing credentials of a Holding Company can be clubbed with only one of the fully owned subsidiary bidding company, with appropriate legal documents proving such owners hip.
- **8. Start-up Enterprises:** Requirements of prior experience and turnover would be relaxed for Start-up enterprises as recognized by Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT), subject to their meeting the quality and technical specifications. Such Start-ups maybe either MSE or otherwise.

9. Notes for Bidders:

- (i) Along with all the necessary documents/ certificates required as per the tender conditions, the bidder should furnish a brief write-up, backed with adequate data, explaining his available capacity (both t echnical and financial), for manufacture and supply of the required goods/ equipment, within the specified time of completion, after me eting all their current commitments.
- (ii) Supporting documents submitted by the bidder must be certifie

d as follows:

- (iii) All copy of supply/ work order; respective completion certificate and contact details of clients; documents issued by the releva nt industries department; National Small Industries Corporatio n (NSIC); manufacturing licence, annual report, etc., in suppor t of experience, past performance and capacity/ capability sh ould be authenticated by the by the person authorized to sign the tender on behalf of the bidder.
- (iv) All financial standing data should be certified by certified accountants, for example, Charted Accountants/ Cost Accountants in India and equivalent in relevant countries; and
- (v) Indian bidder or Indian counterparts of foreign bidders should furnish their Permanent Account Number.
- 10. **LD Clause** If the supplier fails to deliver any or all of the goods or fails to perform the servi ces within the time frame(s) incorporated in the contract, SPMCIL shall, without prejudice to other rights and remedies available to SPMCIL under the contract, deduct from the contract price, as liq uidated damages, a sum equivalent to the ½% percent of the delivered price of the delayed good s and/ or services for each week of delay or part thereof until actual delivery or performance, subject to a maximum deduction of the 10% of the delayed goods' or services' contract price(s).
- **11.** "**GST Return**: Supplier should file the GST returns for outward supplies in time. In case of any I nput credit Loss to BNP by way of their failure to files GST returns in time, BNP reserves the right to withhold the payment of further supplies till production of evidence of filling of returns."
- **12. Capacity verification (if required)**: As part of technical evaluation, if required capacity verificat ion of the bidders may be conducted by BNP. The offer of the firms not meeting the criteria in verification will be rejected.
- **13. Delivery Schedule:** The firm have to supply the material within 98 days from t he date of issue of Contract.
- 14. Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure, Public Procurement Division, Order s (Public Procurement 1, 2 and 3) F.No.6/18/2019-PPD dated 23rd/ 24th July 2020 (or a ny further amendments thereof) regarding eligibility of bidders from specified countrie s shall be applicable to this tender. - 11. Creating bid for items from irrelevant categories.
- 12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
- 13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
- 14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.
