- 1. If the bidder is a Micro or Small Enterprise as per latest definitions under MSME rules, the bidder shall be exempted from the requirement of "Bidder Turnover" criteria and "Experience Criteria" subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. If the bidder is OEM of the offered products, it would be exempted from the "OEM Average Turnover" criteria also subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. In case any bidder is seeking exemption from Turnover / Experience Criteria, the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for exemption must be uploaded for evaluation by the buyer.
- 2. - 3. Preference to Make In India products (For bids < 200 Crore):Preference shall be given to Class 1 local supplier as defined in public procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products. The minimum local content to qualify as a Class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must upload a certificate from the OEM regarding the percentage of the local content and the details of locations at which the local value addition is made along with their bid, failing which no purchase preference shall be granted. - 4. Purchase preference will be given to MSEs having valid Udyam Registration and whose credentials are validated online through Udyam Registration portal as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail themselves of the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer / OEM of the offered product on GeM. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises and hence resellers offering products manufactured by some other OEM are not eligible for any purchase preference. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service and Buyer will decide eligibility for purchase preference based on documentary evidence submitted, while evaluating the bid. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has / have quoted price within L-1+ 15% (Selected by Buyer) of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such MSE Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for 100% (selected by Buyer) percentage of total quantity. The buyers are advised to refer the OM No. F.1/4/2021-PPD dated 18.05.2023 OM No.1 4 2021 PPD dated 18.05.2023 for compliance of Concurrent application of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises Order, 2012 and Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) Order, 2017. Benefits of MSE will be allowed only if seller is validated on-line in GeM profile as well as validated and approved by Buyer after evaluation of documents submitted.
- 5. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and

for determining the Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has no relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. Also this is not going to be used as a criteria in determining reasonableness of quoted prices which would be determined by the buyer based on its own assessment of reasonableness and based on competitive prices received in Bid / RA process.

- 6. Reverse Auction would be conducted amongst all the technically qualified bidders except the Highest quoting bidder. The technically qualified Highest Quoting bidder will not be allowed to participate in RA. However, H-1 will also be allowed to participate in RA in following cases:

(iii) Financial Standing:-

- 2. Applicability to 'Make in India': Bidders (manufacturer or principal of authorized representative) If the product is being manufactured in India under a license from a foreign manufacturer who holds inte llectual property rights and where there is a technology collaboration agreement/ transfer of technolog y agreement for indigenous manufacture of a product developed abroad with clear phased increase in local content, and who while meeting all other criteria above, except for any or more of sub-criteria in Experience and Past Performance above, would also be considered to be qualified provided: i) their for eign manufacturer who holds intellectual property rights, meets all the criteria above without exempti on, and ii) the Bidder submits appropriate documentary proof for technology collaboration agreement/ transfer of technology agreement for indigenous manufacture of a product developed abroad with clear phased increase in local content. Iii) the bidder (manufacturer or principal of authorized representative) furnishes along with the bid a legally enforceable undertaking jointly executed by himself and such foreign Manufacturer for satisfactory manufacture, Supply (and erection, commissioning if applicable) and performance of 'The Product' offered including all warranty obligations as per the general and special conditions of contract.
- 3. For Authorized Representatives: Bids of bidders quoting as authorized representative of a principa I manufacturer would also be considered to be qualified, provided: i) their principal manufacturer meet s all the criteria above without exemption, and ii) the principal manufacturer furnishes a legally enforc eable tender-specific authorization in the prescribed form assuring full guarantee and warranty obligati ons as per the general and special conditions of contract; and iii) the bidder himself should have been

associated, as authorized representative of the same or other Principal Manufacturer for same set of se rvices as in present bid (supply, installation, satisfactorily commissioning, after sales service as the ca se may be) for same or similar 'Product' for past three years ending on 'The Relevant Date'.

- **4. For Existing successful Past Suppliers**: In case the bidder (manufacturer or principal of authorized representative) who is a successful past supplier of **SITC 200 KVA DG set** in at least one of the recen t past three procurements (within SPMCIL/ BRBNMPL/BNPMIPL), who do not meet any or more of requir ements above, would also be considered to be qualified in view of their proven credentials, for the ma ximum quantity supplied by him in such recent past to any units of SPMCIL.
- **5. Joint Ventures and Holding Companies**: Credentials of the partners of Joint ventures cannot (repe at cannot) be clubbed for the purpose of compliance of PQC in supply of Goods/Equipment, and each p artner must comply with all the PQC criteria independently. However, for the purpose of qualifying the Financial Standing Criteria, the Financial Standing credentials of a Holding Company can be clubbed wi th only one of the fully owned subsidiary bidding company, with appropriate legal documents proving s uch ownership.
- **6. Start-up Enterprises**: Requirements of prior experience and turnover would be relaxed for Start-up e nterprises as recognized by Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT), subject to their meeting the quality and technical specifications. - **8. Delivery Schedule**: The bidder on whom contract will be placed will have to supply, install & comm ission the machine/equipment within 180 days from the issue of contract.
- 9. Liquidated Damages: If the supplier fails to deliver any or all of the goods or fails to perform the ser vices within the time frame(s) incorporated in the contract, SPMCIL shall, without prejudice to other rig hts and remedies available to SPMCIL under the contract, deduct from the contract price, as liquidated damages, a sum equivalent to the ½% of the delivered price of the delayed goods and/ or services for each week of delay or part thereof until actual delivery or performance, subject to a maximum deducti on of the 10% of the delayed goods' or services' contract price(s).
- **10. GST return**: The Supplier should file the GST returns for outward supplies in time. In case of any inp ut credit loss to BNP by way of their failure to file GST returns in time, BNP reserves the right to withh old the payment of further supplies till production of evident of filling of returns.

- 11. Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure, Public Procureme nt Division, Orders (Public Procurement 1, 2 and 3) F.No.6/18/2019-PPD dated 23rd/ 24th July 2020 (or any further amendments thereo f) regarding eligibility of bidders from specified countries shall be a pplicable to this tender. Salient features of this are:
 - **I.** Any bidder from a country which shares a land border with India (excluding countries as listed on the website of Ministry of External Affairs, to which the Government of India has extended lines of credit or in which the Government of India is engaged in development projects) will be eligible to bid in this tender only if the bidder is registered with the Registration Committee constituted by the Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT). "Bidder" (including the term 'tenderer', 'consultant' or 'service provi der' in certain contexts) means any person or firm or company, includin g any member of a consortium or joint venture (that is an association of several persons, or firms or companies), every artificial juridical person not falling in any of the descriptions of bidders stated hereinbefore, including any agency branch or office controlled by such person, participating in a procurement process.
- IV. "Bidder from a country which shares a land border with India" for th

e purpose of this Order means:-

- (a) An entity incorporated, established, or registered in such a country; or
- (b) A subsidiary of an entity incorporated, established, or registered in s uch a country; or
- (c) An entity substantially controlled through entities incorporated, esta blished, or registered in such a country; or
- (d) An entity whose beneficial owner is situated in such a country; or
- (e) An Indian (or other) agent of such an entity; or
- (f) A natural person who is a citizen of such a country; or
- (g) A consortium or joint venture where any member of the consortium or joint venture falls under any of the above
- **V.** The beneficial owner for the purpose of (III) above will be as under:
- (a) In case of a company or Limited Liability Partnership, the beneficial owner is the natural person(s). Who, whether acting alone or together, or through one or more juridical person, has a controlling ownership int erest or who exercises control through other means.

(b) Explanation-

- **1.** "Controlling ownership interest" means ownership of or entitlement t o more than twenty-five per cent. of shares or capital or profits of the c ompany.
- **2.** In case of a partnership firm, the beneficial owner is the natural pers on(s) who, whether acting alone or together, or through one or more jur idical person, has ownership of entitlement to more than fifteen percent of capital or profits of the partnership.
- **3.** In case of an unincorporated association or body of individuals, the b eneficial owner is the natural person(s), who, whether acting alone or to gether, or through one or more juridical person, has ownership of or ent itlement to more than fifteen percent of the property or capital or profit s of such association or body of individuals;
- **4.** Where no natural person is identified under (1) or (2) or (3) above, the beneficial owner is the relevant natural person who holds the position of

senior managing official.

5. In case of a trust, the identification of beneficial owner(s) shall includ e identification of the author of the trust, the trustee, the beneficiaries with

fifteen percent or more interest in the trust and any other natural perso n exercising ultimate effective control over the trust through a chain of control or ownership.

VI. An Agent is a person employed to do any act for another, or to repr esent another in dealings with third person.

12. Warranty clause:

(a) The supplier warrants that the goods supplied under the contract is new, un used, and incorporate all recent improvements in design and materials unless p rescribed otherwise by SPMCIL in the contract. The supplier further warrants that the goods supplied under the contract shall have no defect

arising from design, materials (except when the design adopted and / or the material used are as per SPMCIL's specifications) or workmanship or from any act or omission of the supplier, that may develop under normal use of the supplied goods under the conditions prevailing in India.

- (b) This warranty shall remain valid for twenty-four months after the goods or a ny portion thereof as the case may be, have been delivered to the final destination and installed and commissioned at the final destination and accepte d by SPMCIL in terms of the contract.
- (c) In case of any claim arising out of this warranty, SPMCIL shall promptly notify the same in writing t o the supplier.
- (d) Upon receipt of such notice, the supplier shall, with all reasonable speed (or within the period, if s pecified in the SCC), repair or replace the defective goods or parts thereof, free of cost, at the ultimat e destination. The supplier shall take over the replaced parts/ goods after providing their replacement s and no claim, whatsoever shall lie on SPMCIL for such replaced parts/ goods thereafter.
- (e) In the event of any rectification of a defect or replacement of any defective g oods during the warr anty period, the warranty for the rectified/ replaced goods shall be extended to a further period of tw elve months from the date such rectified / replaced goods starts functioning to the satisfaction of SP MCIL.
- (f) If the supplier, having been notified, fails to rectify/ replace the defect(s) within a reasonable perio d (or within the period, if specified in the SCC), SPMCIL may proceed to take such remedial action(s) as deemed fit by SPMCIL, at the risk a nd expense of the supplier and without prejudice to other contractual rights and remedies, which SPMCIL may have against the supplier.
- **13. Compulsory site visit:** The bidder before quoting the tender, has to comp ulsorily visit and examin e the installation site and its surroundings and obtain fo r itself on its own responsibility all informatio n that may be necessary for preparing the bid and submit the site survey report along with the tende r documents. The costs of visiting the site shall be borne by the bidder.
- **14. Documents Checklist:-** The participating bidder shall also submit the documents as per following mentioned order:-
 - (i) Seal & signed Bid/Tender document as an unconditional acceptance of all terms & conditions o f bid.
 - (ii) Seal & signed technical specifications, scope of work & Service Level Agreement.

 - (iv) Audited Balance sheet & Profit and loss statement of FY 2021-22, FY2022-23 & FY 2023-24 dul y certified by Chartered Accountant/ Cost Accountant in India or equivalent in relevant countrie s.
 - (v) Technical catalogue of offered make/models of D.G.Set.
 - (vi) Detailed bill of material for Sr. No.3(1), i.e. SITC of 200 KVA D.G.Set with AMF Control panel sep arately mentioning all the Electrical devices safety devices and instrument devices.
 - (vii) Declaration regarding local content with details of location at which value addition activity is b eing done, if bidder has applied for Make in India purchase preference.
 - (viii) Undertaking/Declaration certificate that you are currently not suspended/Banned/Blacklisted by any ministry/ department of govt. of India or by any state govt. for business dealing.

15. Note for bidders:

i. Along with all the necessary documents/ certificates required as per the bid conditions, the bid der should furnish a brief write-up, backed with adequate data, explaining his available capacity (both technical and financial), for manufacture and supply of the required goods/ equipment, wi thin the specified time of completion, after meeting all their current commitments.

- **b.** All financial standing data should be certified by certified accountants, for example, Chartered Accountants/ Cost Accountants in India and equivalent in relevant countries; and

16. By participating in this tender, the suppliers/Vendors/Contractors are deemed to have undertaken that they shall not give or take, any financial or non-financial bribe, to or from anyone during the tender or during the execution of the contract thereafter and if they notice any such incident happening, they shall report it to Vigilance.

8. **Certificates**

Bidder's offer is liable to be rejected if they don't upload any of the certificates / documents sought in the Bid document, ATC and Corrigendum if any.
