- 1. If the bidder is a Micro or Small Enterprise as per latest definitions under MSME rules, the bidder shall be exempted from the requirement of "Bidder Turnover" criteria and "Experience Criteria" subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. If the bidder is OEM of the offered products, it would be exempted from the "OEM Average Turnover" criteria also subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. In case any bidder is seeking exemption from Turnover / Experience Criteria, the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for exemption must be uploaded for evaluation by the buyer.
- 2. If the bidder is a Startup, the bidder shall be exempted from the requirement of "Bidder Turnover" criteria and "Experience Criteria" subject to their meeting of quality and technical specifications. If the bidder is OEM of the offered products, it would be exempted from the "OEM Average Turnover" criteria also subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. In case any bidder is seeking exemption from Turnover / Experience Criteria, the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for exemption must be uploaded for evaluation by the buyer.
- 3. Preference to Make In India products (For bids < 200 Crore):Preference shall be given to Class 1 local supplier as defined in public procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products. The minimum local content to qualify as a Class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must upload a certificate from the OEM regarding the percentage of the local content and the details of locations at which the local value addition is made along with their bid, failing which no purchase preference shall be granted. - 4. Purchase preference will be given to MSEs having valid Udyam Registration and whose credentials are validated online through Udyam Registration portal as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail themselves of the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer / OEM of the offered product on GeM. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises and hence resellers offering products manufactured by some other OEM are not eligible for any purchase preference. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service and Buyer will decide eligibility for purchase preference based on documentary evidence submitted, while evaluating the bid. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has / have quoted price within L-1+ 15% (Selected by Buyer) of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such MSE Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for 100% (selected by Buyer) percentage of total quantity. The buyers are advised to refer the OM No. F.1/4/2021-PPD dated 18.05.2023 OM No.1 4 2021 PPD dated 18.05.2023 for compliance of Concurrent application of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises Order, 2012 and Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) Order, 2017. Benefits of MSE will be allowed only if seller is validated on-line in GeM profile as well as validated and approved by Buyer after evaluation of documents submitted.
- 5. Reverse Auction would be conducted amongst all the technically qualified bidders except the Highest quoting bidder. The technically qualified Highest Quoting bidder will not be allowed to participate in RA. However, H-1

will also be allowed to participate in RA in following cases:

- i. If number of technically qualified bidders are only 2 or 3.
- ii. If Buyer has chosen to split the bid amongst N sellers, and H1 bid is coming within N.
- iii. In case Primary product of only one OEM is left in contention for participation in RA on elimination of H-1.
- iv. If L-1 is non-MSE and H-1 is eligible MSE and H-1 price is coming within price band of 15% of Non-MSE L-1

1. Generic

OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity by up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. Bidders are bound to accept the orders accordingly.

2. Forms of EMD and PBG

Bidders can also submit the EMD with Account Payee Demand Draft in favour of

7. Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC

Buyer Added text based ATC clauses

- (i) Experience & Past Performance:- The bidder (manufacturer or principal of authorized represe ntative hereinafter referred simply as 'The Bidder') shall be a manufacturer that has regularly for at least the last three years manufactured, supplied, erected, commissioned High Speed Shred ding cum Briquetting Machine with the same or higher specifications of at least one number in last five years ending on "31.03.2024". At least one number of the product offered for supply should be in successful operation for at least one year on the date of bid opening.
- (ii) Capability- Equipment & manufacturing Facilities:- The bidder must have an annual capaci ty to manufacture and supply at least 01 similar High Speed Shredding cum Briquetting Machine.

Note: At the discretion of the purchaser, the capacity & capability assessment/ verification of bidd er/manufacturer firms shall be undertaken by technical committee or through a third party technic al consultancy/inspection agencies to ensure that firms are identified and capable to develop the it em as required.

(iii) Financial Standing:-

- (1) The average annual financial turnover of the bidder firm (manufacturer or principal of authorized dealer) during the last three years, ending on '31.03.2024' should be at Rs. 3, 58, 00,000/- or equi valent in foreign currency at exchange rate prevailing on 31.03.2024 as per the annual report (aud ited balance sheet and profit & loss account) of the relevant period duly authenticated by a Charte red Accountant/ Cost Accountant in India or equivalent in relevant countries.
- (2) The net worth of the firm should
 - a. not be negative on '31.03.2024' and
 - b. not have eroded by more than 30% in the last three years, ending on '31.03.2024'.

Note 1: To ascertain criteria net worth of initial and last financial year shall be compared. To ascertain financial standing criteria, bidders must submit seal & signed Balance Sheet & Profit a nd loss statement of last 3 financial year i.e FY2021-22, FY 2022-23 & FY 2023-24, duly certified by Chartered Accountants/ Cost Accountants.

Note 2: For MSEs and Start-ups (registered for the tendered item) all financial criteria & Experienc e and past performance criteria shall be exempted. However, its capacity and capability may be ve rified (if necessary) by the buyer.

- 2. Applicability to 'Make in India' :Bidders (manufacturer or principal of authorized representati ve) If the product is being manufactured in India under a license from a foreign manufacturer who holds intellectual property rights and where there is a technology collaboration agreement/ transfe r of technology agreement for indigenous manufacture of a product developed abroad with clear p hased increase in local content, and who while meeting all other criteria above, except for any or more of sub-criteria in Experience and Past Performance above, would also be considered to be qu alified provided: i) their foreign manufacturer who holds intellectual property rights, meets all the criteria above without exemption, and ii) the Bidder submits appropriate documentary proof for te chnology collaboration agreement/ transfer of technology agreement for indigenous manufacture of a product developed abroad with clear phased increase in local content. Iii) the bidder (manufact urer or principal of authorized representative) furnishes along with the bid a legally enforceable un dertaking jointly executed by himself and such foreign Manufacturer for satisfactory manufacture, Supply (and erection, commissioning if applicable) and performance of 'The Product' offered including all warranty obligations as per the general and special conditions of contract.
- 3. **For Authorized Representatives:** Bids of bidders quoting as authorized representative of a pr incipal manufacturer would also be considered to be qualified, provided: i) their principal manufact urer meets all the criteria above without exemption, and ii) the principal manufacturer furnishes a l egally enforceable tender-specific authorization in the prescribed form assuring full guarantee and warranty obligations as per the general and special conditions of contract; and iii) the bidder himse lf should have been associated, as authorized representative of the same or other Principal Manufa cturer for same set of services as in present bid (supply, installation, satisfactorily commissioning, after sales service as the case may be) for same or similar 'Product' for past three years ending on 'The Relevant Date'.
- 4. **For Existing successful Past Suppliers:** In case the bidder (manufacturer or principal of auth orized representative) who is a successful past supplier of **High Speed Shredding cum Briquett ing Machine** in at least one of the recent past three procurements (within SPMCIL/ BRBNMPL/BNP MIPL), who do not meet any or more of requirements above, would also be considered to be qualified in view of their proven credentials, for the maximum quantity supplied by him in such recent past to any units of SPMCIL.
- 5. **Joint Ventures and Holding Companies:** Credentials of the partners of Joint ventures cannot (repeat cannot) be clubbed for the purpose of compliance of PQC in supply of Goods/Equipment, a

nd each partner must comply with all the PQC criteria independently. However, for the purpose of qualifying the Financial Standing Criteria, the Financial Standing credentials of a Holding Company can be clubbed with only one of the fully owned subsidiary bidding company, with appropriate legal documents proving such ownership.

6. Start-up Enterprises: Requirements of prior experience and turnover would be relaxed for Star t-up enterprises as recognized by Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT), subject to their meeting the quality and technical specifications. Such Start-ups maybe either MSE or otherwise

7. Payment Terms:-

- (i) 80% of the machine cost on receipt and acceptance of goods by the consignee at destination and on production of all required documents by the supplier
- (ii) 20% of machine cost and 100% of the installation, commissioning and training (ICT) cost on s uccessful installation, commissioning and acceptance by the user department
 - Payment will be done through RTGS Only.
 - Paying Authority: Head of Finance, Bank Note Press Dewas
 - 8. **Delivery Schedule:-** The bidder on whom purchase order will be placed will have to supply, ins tall & commissioned the machine/equipment within 10 months from the date of release of purchas e order.
 - 9. **Liquidated Damages:** If the supplier fails to deliver any or all of the goods or fails to perform t he services within the time frame(s) incorporated in the contract, SPMCIL shall, without prejudice t o other rights and remedies available to SPMCIL under the contract, deduct from the contract price, as liquidated damages, a sum equivalent to the ½% percent of the delivered price of the delayed goods and/ or services for each week of delay or part thereof until actual delivery or performance, subject to a maximum deduction of the 10% of the delayed goods' or services' contract price(s).
 - 10. **GST Return:** Supplier should file the GST returns for outward supplies in time. In case of any Inp ut credit Loss to BNP by way of their failure to files GST returns in time, BNP reserves the right to w ithhold the payment of further supplies till production of evidence of filling of returns."

11. Note for the bidders:-

- i. Along with all the necessary documents/ certificates required as per the bid conditions, the bidd er should furnish a brief write-up, backed with adequate data, explaining his available capacity (bo th technical and financial), for manufacture and supply of the required goods/ equipment, within the specified time of completion, after meeting all their current commitments.
- ii. Supporting documents submitted by the bidder must be certified as follows:
- a. All copy of supply/ work order; respective completion certificate/Invoice copy and contact details of clients; documents issued by the relevant Industries Department; National Small Industries Corp oration (NSIC); manufacturing licence, annual report, etc., in support of experience, past performa nce and capacity/ capability should be authenticated by the by the person authorised to sign the t ender on behalf of the bidder.
- b. All financial standing data should be certified by certified accountants, for example, Chartered A ccountants/ Cost Accountants in India and equivalent in relevant countries; and
- iii. Indian bidder or Indian counterparts of foreign bidders should furnish their Permanent Account N umber.
- 12. "By participating in this tender, the suppliers/Vendors/Contractors are deemed to have undertaken that they shall not give or take, any financial or non-financial bribe, to or from anyone during the tender or during the execution of the contract thereafter and if they notice any such incident happening, they shall report it to Vigilance."
- 13. Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure, Public Procurement Division, Orders (Public Procurement 1, 2 and 3) F.No.6/18/2019-PPD dated 23rd/24th July 2020 (or any furt her amendments thereof) regarding eligibility of bidders from specified countries shall be applicable to this tender. Salient features of this are:

I. Any bidder from a country which shares a land border with India (excluding countries as listed on the website of Ministry of External Affairs, to which the Government of India has extended lines of cr edit or in which the Government of India is engaged in development projects) will be eligible to bid in this tender only if the bidder is registered with the Registration Committee constituted by the Dep

artment for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT). The bidders shall enclose following cert ificate in this regard:

"We have read the clause regarding restrictions on procurement from a bidder of a country which s hares a land border with India; and solemnly certify that we are not from such a country or, if from s uch a country, we are registered with the Competent Authority (copy enclosed). We hereby certify t hat we fulfill all requirements in this regard and are eligible to be considered."

II. In tenders for Turnkey contracts including Works contracts, the successful bidder shall not be allo wed to sub-contract works to any contractor from a country which shares a land border with India u nless such contractor is similarly registered with the Registration Committee constituted by the Dep artment for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT). In such cases the bidders shall enclose following certificate:

"We have read the clause regarding restrictions on procurement from a bidder of a country which s hares a land border with India and on sub-contracting to contractors from such countries,; and sole mnly certify that we are not from such a country or, if from such a country, we are registered with t he Competent Authority (copy enclosed) and we will not subcontract any work to a contractor from such countries unless such contractor is registered with the Competent Authority. We hereby certify that we fulfill all requirements in this regard and are eligible to be considered."

III. "Bidder" (including the term 'tenderer', 'consultant' or 'service provider' in certain contexts) mea ns any person or firm or company, including any member of a consortium or joint venture (that is an association of several persons, or firms or companies), every artificial juridical person not falling in a ny of the descriptions of bidders stated hereinbefore, including any agency branch or office controll ed by such person, participating in a procurement process.

- IV. "Bidder from a country which shares a land border with India" for the purpose of this Order mea ns: -
- (a) An entity incorporated, established, or registered in such a country; or
- (b) A subsidiary of an entity incorporated, established, or registered in such a country; or
- (c) An entity substantially controlled through entities incorporated, established, or registered in suc h a country; or
- (d) An entity whose beneficial owner is situated in such a country; or
- (e) An Indian (or other) agent of such an entity; or
- (f) A natural person who is a citizen of such a country; or
- (g) A consortium or joint venture where any member of the consortium or joint venture falls under a ny of the above
- V. The beneficial owner for the purpose of (III) above will be as under:
- (a) In case of a company or Limited Liability Partnership, the beneficial owner is the natural person(
- s). Who, whether acting alone or together, or through one or more juridical person, has a controlling ownership interest or who exercises control through other means.
- (b) Explanation-
- 1. "Controlling ownership interest" means ownership of or entitlement to more than twenty-five per cent. of shares or capital or profits of the company.
- 2. In case of a partnership firm, the beneficial owner is the natural person(s) who, whether acting alo ne or together, or through one or more juridical person, has ownership of entitlement to more than f ifteen percent of capital or profits of the partnership.
- 3. In case of an unincorporated association or body of individuals, the beneficial owner is the natural person(s), who, whether acting alone or together, or through one or more juridical person, has owne rship of or entitlement to more than fifteen percent of the property or capital or profits of such association or body of individuals;
- 4. Where no natural person is identified under (1) or (2) or (3) above, the beneficial owner is the rele vant natural person who holds the position of senior managing official.
- 5. In case of a trust, the identification of beneficial owner(s) shall include identification of the author of the trust, the trustee, the beneficiaries with fifteen percent or more interest in the trust and any o ther natural person exercising ultimate effective control over the trust through a chain of control or ownership.
- VI. An Agent is a person employed to do any act for another, or to represent another in dealings wit h third person.

14. Warrantee Clause:-

- (i) The supplier warrants that the goods supplied under the contract is new, unused, and incorporate all re cent improvements in design and materials unless prescribed otherwise by SPMCIL in the contract. The su pplier further warrants that the goods supplied under the contract shall have no defect arising from design , materials (except when the design adopted and / or the material used are as per SPMCIL's specifications) or workmanship or from any act or omission of the supplier, that may develop under normal use of the supplied goods under the conditions prevailing in India.
- (ii) This warranty shall remain valid for twelve months after the goods or any portion thereof as the case m ay be, have been delivered to the final destination and installed and commissioned at the final destination and accepted by SPMCIL in terms of the contract or for fifteen months from the date of despatch from the supplier's premises for domestic goods (including goods already imported by the supplier under its own ar rangement) or for eighteen months after the date of shipment from the port of loading in the source country for imported goods offered from abroad, whichever is earlier.
- (iii) In case of any claim arising out of this warranty, SPMCIL shall promptly notify the same in writing to the supplier.
- (iv) Upon receipt of such notice, the supplier shall, with all reasonable speed (or within the period, if specifi ed in the SCC), repair or replace the defective goods or parts thereof, free of cost, at the ultimate destinati on. The supplier shall take over the replaced parts/ goods after providing their replacements and no claim, whatsoever shall lie on SPMCIL for such replaced parts/ goods thereafter.
- (v) In the event of any rectification of a defect or replacement of any defective goods during the warranty period, the warranty for the rectified/ replaced goods shall be extended to a further period of twelve mont hs from the date such rectified / replaced goods starts functioning to the satisfaction of SPMCIL.
- (vi) If the supplier, having been notified, fails to rectify/ replace the defect(s) within a reasonable period (or within the period, if specified in the SCC), SPMCIL may proceed to take such remedial action(s) as deemed fit by SPMCIL, at the risk and expense of the supplier and without prejudice to other contractual rights and remedies, which SPMCIL may have against the supplier.
