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1. If the bidder is a Micro or Small Enterprise as per latest definitions under MSME rules, the bidder shall be exempted from the requirement of "Bidder Turnover" criteria and "Experience Criteria" subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. 4. Purchase preference will be given to MSEs having valid Udyam Registration and whose credentials are validated online through Udyam Registration portal as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail themselves of the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer / OEM of the offered product on GeM. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises and hence resellers offering products manufactured by some other OEM are not eligible for any purchase preference. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Product or service and Buyer will decide eligibility for purchase preference based on documentary evidence submitted, while evaluating the bid. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has / have quoted price within L-1+ 15% (Selected by Buyer) of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such MSE Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for 100% (selected by Buyer) percentage of total quantity. 5. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for determining the Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has no relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. Also this is not going to be used as a criteria in determining reasonableness of quoted prices which would be determined by the buyer based on its own assessment of reasonableness and based on competitive prices received in Bid / RA process.

6. Reverse Auction would be conducted amongst all the technically qualified bidders except the Highest quoting bidder. The technically qualified Highest Quoting bidder will not be allowed to participate in RA. However, H-1 will also be allowed to participate in RA in following cases:

1. Generic

OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. The delivery period of quantity shall commence from the last date of original delivery order and in cases where option clause is exercised during the extended delivery period the

additional time shall commence from the last date of extended delivery period. The additional delivery time shall be (Increased quantity ÷ Original quantity) × Original delivery period (in days), subject to minimum of 30 days. If the original delivery period is less than 30 days, the additional time equals the original delivery period. The Purchaser may extend this calculated delivery duration up to the original delivery period while exercising the option clause. Bidders must comply with these terms.

2. The bidder firm should meet following eligibility criteria to qualify:

(b). For other firm - Experience and past performance: Experience and past perfor mance: The bidder should have experience of having successfully supplied relevant servic es of 40% of the estimated tendered value of tender requirement in any one of the last five years ending on 31.03.2024.

- **3. Liquidated Damages**: If the supplier fails to deliver any or all of the goods or fails to perf orm the services within the time frame(s) incorporated in the contract, SPMCIL shall, witho ut prejudice to other rights and remedies available to SPMCIL under the contract, deduct fr om the contract price, as liquidated damages, a sum equivalent to the ½% of the delivered price of the delayed goods and/ or services for each week of delay or part thereof until act ual delivery or performance, subject to a maximum deduction of the 10% of the delayed g oods' or services' contract price(s).
- **4. GST return**: The Supplier should file the GST returns for outward supplies in time. Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure, Public Procurement Division, O rders (Public Procurement 1, 2 and 3) F.No.6/18/2019-PPD dated 23rd/ 24th July 2020 (or any further amendments thereof) regarding eligibility of bidders from s pecified countries shall be applicable to this tender. Salient features of this are:

I. Any bidder from a country which shares a land border with India (excl uding countries as listed on the website of Ministry of External Affairs, t o which the Government of India has extended lines of credit or in whic h the Government of India is engaged in development projects) will be eligible to bid in this tender only if the bidder is registered with the Regi stration Committee constituted by the Department for Promotion of Ind ustry and Internal Trade (DPIIT). III. "Bidder" (including the term 'tenderer', 'consultant' or 'service provi der' in certain contexts) means any person or firm or company, includin g any member of a consortium or joint venture (that is an association of several persons, or firms or companies), every artificial juridical person not falling in any of the descriptions of bidders stated hereinbefore, including any agency branch or office controlled by such person, participati ng in a procurement process.

IV. "Bidder from a country which shares a land border with India" for th e purpose of this Order means:-

(a) An entity incorporated, established, or registered in such a country; or

(b) A subsidiary of an entity incorporated, established, or registered in s uch a country; or

(c) An entity substantially controlled through entities incorporated, esta blished, or registered in such a country; or

(d) An entity whose beneficial owner is situated in such a country; or

(e) An Indian (or other) agent of such an entity; or

(f) A natural person who is a citizen of such a country; or

(g) A consortium or joint venture where any member of the consortium or joint venture falls under any of the above

V. The beneficial owner for the purpose of (III) above will be as under: (a) In case of a company or Limited Liability Partnership, the beneficial owner is the natural person(s). Who, whether acting alone or together, or through one or more juridical person, has a controlling ownership int erest or who exercises control through other means.

(b) Explanation-

1. "Controlling ownership interest" means ownership of or entitlement t o more than twenty-five per cent. of shares or capital or profits of the c ompany.

2. In case of a partnership firm, the beneficial owner is the natural pers on(s) who, whether acting alone or together, or through one or more jur idical person, has ownership of entitlement to more than fifteen percent of capital or profits of the partnership.

3. In case of an unincorporated association or body of individuals, the b eneficial owner is the natural person(s), who, whether acting alone or to gether, or through one or more juridical person, has ownership of or ent itlement to more than fifteen percent of the property or capital or profit s of such association or body of individuals;

4. Where no natural person is identified under (1) or (2) or (3) above, th e beneficial owner is the relevant natural person who holds the position of

senior managing official.

5. In case of a trust, the identification of beneficial owner(s) shall includ e identification of the author of the trust, the trustee, the beneficiaries with

fifteen percent or more interest in the trust and any other natural perso n exercising ultimate effective control over the trust through a chain of control or ownership.

VI. An Agent is a person employed to do any act for another, or to repr esent another in dealings with third person.

6. Anti-bribery clause: By participating in this tender, the suppliers/Vendors/Contractors are deemed to have undertaken that they shall not give or take, any financial or non-financial bribe, to or from an yone during the tender or during the execution of the contract thereafter and if they notice any such i ncident happening, they shall report it to Vigilance.

7. Warrantee clause:

(a) The supplier warrants that the goods supplied under the contract is new, unused, and incorporate all recent improvements in design and m aterials unless prescribed otherwise by SPMCIL in the contract. The sup plier further warrants that the goods supplied under the contract shall h ave no defect arising from design, materials (except when the design a dopted and / or the material used are as per SPMCIL's specifications) or workmanship or from any act or omission of the supplier, that may deve lop under normal use of the supplied goods under the conditions prevail ing in India.

(b) This warranty shall remain valid for twelve months after the goods o r any portion thereof as the case may be, have been delivered to the fin al destination and installed and commissioned at the final destination a nd accepted by SPMCIL in terms of the contract.

(c) In case of any claim arising out of this warranty, SPMCIL shall promp tly notify the same in writing to the supplier.

(d) Upon receipt of such notice, the supplier shall, with all reasonable speed (or within the period, if specified in the SCC), repair or replace th e defective goods or parts thereof, free of cost, at the ultimate destinati on. The supplier shall take over the replaced parts/ goods after providin g their replacements and no claim, whatsoever shall lie on SPMCIL for s uch replaced parts/ goods thereafter.

(e) In the event of any rectification of a defect or replacement of any de fective goods during the warranty period, the warranty for the rectified/ replaced goods shall be extended to a further period of twelve months f rom the date such rectified / replaced goods starts functioning to the sa tisfaction of SPMCIL.

(f) If the supplier, having been notified, fails to rectify/ replace the defec t(s) within a reasonable period (or within the period, if specified in the S CC), SPMCIL may proceed to take such remedial action(s) as deemed fit by SPMCIL, at the risk and expense of the supplier and without prejudic e to other contractual rights and remedies, which SPMCIL may have ag ainst the supplier.

8. Certificates

Bidder's offer is liable to be rejected if they don't upload any of the certificates / documents sought in the Bid document, ATC and Corrigendum if any.

The additional terms and conditions have been incorporated by the Buyer after approval of the Competent Authority in Buyer Organization, whereby Buyer organization is solely responsible for the impact of these clauses on the bidding process, its outcome, and consequences thereof including any eccentricity / restriction arising in the bidding process due to these ATCs and due to modification of technical specifications and / or terms and conditions governing the bid. If any clause(s) is / are incorporated by the Buyer regarding following, the bid and resultant contracts shall be treated as null and void and such bids may be cancelled by GeM at any stage of bidding process without any notice:-

- 1. Definition of Class I and Class II suppliers in the bid not in line with the extant Order / Office Memorandum issued by DPIIT in this regard.
- 2. Seeking EMD submission from bidder(s), including via Additional Terms & Conditions, in contravention to exemption provided to such sellers under GeM GTC.
- 3. Publishing Custom / BOQ bids for items for which regular GeM categories are available without any Category item bunched with it.
- 4. Creating BoQ bid for single item.
- 5. Mentioning specific Brand or Make or Model or Manufacturer or Dealer name.
- 6. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
- 7. Floating / creation of work contracts as Custom Bids in Services.
- 8. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process. (However, in bids for <u>attached categories</u>, trials are allowed as per approved procurement policy of the buyer nodal Ministries)
- 9. Mandating foreign / international certifications even in case of existence of Indian Standards without specifying equivalent Indian Certification / standards.
- 10. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
- 11. Creating bid for items from irrelevant categories.
- 12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
- 13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
- 14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.

Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.
