- 7. 2. Technical capability of the firm:

The bidder must have completed at least one similar environmental monitoring assig nment (stack/ambient/DG set/incinerator monitoring) for any Government Departme nt/PSU/Autonomous Body/Industry during the last five years ending on 31.03.2025.

3. NABL Accreditation:

The bidder must either have an in-house NABL-accredited laboratory, or have a valid MoU/Agreement with a NABL-accredited laboratory. The accreditation must include r elevant parameters such as PM2.5, PM10, SO₂, NOx, CO, and SPM.

4. Instruments & Calibration:

All instruments to be used for measurement shall comply with CPCB norms, and shall have valid calibration certificates traceable to NABL/NPL laboratories.

4. Certificates
