10. Brief Description:

i) Background and Scope of Work

Bank Note Press, Dewas uses Block Board Boxes as consumable packing material for packing 100 poly-pack bundles of currency notes, after placing the HDPE bag inside the box. The present EOI is being floated with the objective of obtaining wider market participation and assessing the realistic prevailing market cost of Block Board Boxes suitable for the requirements of BNP, Dewas. The detailed technical specifications and requirements of the Block Board Boxes are enclosed as Annexure-A.

ii) The proposed procurement shall broadly cover:

- Manufacture/supply of Block Board Boxes conforming to the technical specifications and quality requirements of BNP.
- Supply of the required quantity of Block Board Boxes as per the final tender requirement.
- Compliance with the approved technical specifications, dimensions, material and other requirements specified in Annexure-A.
- Submission of all relevant technical details, product specifications, manufacturing facilities and experience by interested firms.
- The final procurement/tender shall be processed after evaluation of the responses received against this EOI and finalization of the requirement and specifications.

iii. Interested firms may submit the following:

- Letter of Interest.
- Company/Firm profile and product catalogue/brochure.
- Details of manufacturing facilities and infrastructure available for manufacture/supply of Block Board Boxes.



- d) Details of similar Block Board Boxes manufactured/supplied by the firm.
- e) Reference list of customers to whom similar Block Board Boxes or similar products have been supplied during the last five years, preferably to Government Departments/PSUs/large industrial organizations.
- f) Copies of Purchase Orders/Work Orders/Contracts in support of the above experience.
- g) Details of technical specifications of the Block Board Boxes offered/proposed by the firm.
- h) Details of quality standards, quality-control facilities and testing arrangements available with the firm.
- i) Details of annual turnover and audited Balance Sheet and Profit & Loss Account for the last three financial years.
- j) Declaration that the firm has not been blacklisted/debarred by the Government of India or any Government Department/PSU, as applicable.
- k) Budgetary quotation/indicative price for the Block Board Boxes for the purpose of market assessment and determination of realistic market cost.
- l) Any other information considered relevant by the firm for assessment of its capability.
- iv). Quantity Requirement: The indicative requirement of BNP, Dewas for FY 2026-27, as considered in the proposal for EOI, is as follows:

The above quantity is indicative and may be revised depending upon the actual requirement. Requirement of CNP, Nashik, if included subsequently, may also be incorporated in the final procurement requirement.

iv) The Block Board Boxes area regular packing material used at BNP and the primary objective of this EOI is to:

- ascertain the realistic market cost of block board boxes through wider market assessment and transparent price discovery
- Obtain wider market participation.
- Assess the availability of capable manufacturers/suppliers.
- Obtain technical inputs from prospective manufacturers/suppliers.
- Ascertain the realistic market cost of Block Board Boxes.
- Obtain inputs for finalization/refinement of technical specifications, wherever required.
- Facilitate preparation of a subsequent tender enquiry for procurement of Block Board Boxes.

The EOI shall not constitute a purchase order, rate contract or commitment to procure any quantity from any participating firm.

11. Important Instructions for Submission of Documents

- Participating firms shall submit complete technical details, capabilities of the firm, product catalogues, specifications and relevant information regarding the proposed Block Board Boxes.
- The participating firms shall furnish details of their experience in manufacturing/supply of Block Board Boxes or similar products.
- The documents submitted in support of the EOI shall be duly signed by the authorized representative of the applicant, indicating name and designation of the signatory.
- Documents in support of experience, such as Purchase Orders/Work Orders/Supply Orders, performance certificates and customer details, shall be submitted duly authenticated/signed by the authorized representative.
- Firms shall provide details of their manufacturing facilities, quality-control arrangements and production capacity.



- vi. Firms are requested to submit ****budgetary/indicative quotations**** for the Block Board Boxes for the purpose of market assessment and determination of realistic market cost.
- vii. The budgetary quotation submitted against this EOI shall be treated only as an indicative market assessment and shall not confer any right upon the firm for placement of an order.
- viii. Firms may visit BNP, Dewas, if considered necessary, to understand the requirement, packing methodology and scope of supply, subject to prior permission of BNP.
- ix. Firms may submit their technical inputs/proposals in accordance with the broad technical requirements enclosed as Annexure-A.
- x. BNP reserves the right to seek clarification/additional information from participating firms, wherever considered necessary.

12. Pre EOI Conference

A conference may be organized on receipt of queries, clarification or any other points required to be discussed with reference to this EOI. For this purpose, interested bidder may raise the same through email (Bnppurchase@sPMCIL.com) within 7 days of publish of this EOI

13. Procurement Process

The following process is envisaged:

- i. Initially, an Expression of Interest is being floated for Block Board Boxes to obtain wider market participation and ascertain the realistic market trend.
- ii. Interested firms may submit their technical details, credentials, experience, manufacturing capabilities and budgetary quotations in response to the EOI.
- iii. The responses received against the EOI shall be evaluated by the competent committee(s), including the Special Tender Evaluation Committee (STEC) and Price Committee, as applicable, for assessment of technical suitability and realistic market trend.
- iv. The market assessment/evaluation shall be carried out considering the prevailing market conditions, technical specifications, quantity requirement and other relevant factors.
- v. Based on the outcome of the EOI and evaluation thereof, the technical specifications and other terms and conditions may be finalized/refined, as deemed necessary.
- vi. Thereafter, a subsequent tender enquiry/open tender may be floated for procurement of Block Board Boxes incorporating the finalized specifications, terms and conditions and requirement of the purchaser.
- vii. Participation in this EOI shall not create any right or preference in favour of any firm in the subsequent tender.

14. Language

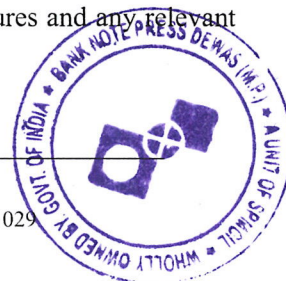
The response to the EOI shall be submitted in English language only. Authenticated copies of supporting documents may also be submitted in English.

16. Quality and Technical Information

Firms shall submit details of quality standards, testing facilities, quality-control procedures and any relevant certifications/accreditations available with them.

Interested firms may submit their EOI response through the e-tendering portal/CPP Portal on or before the closing date and time specified therein.

The firms shall upload the EOI response along with scanned copies of all required documents as specified in the EOI document.

Offline submissions shall not be accepted.

SPECIFICATION FOR PACKING CASES MADE OUT OF BLOCK BOARD

The packing cases of size as mentioned below shall be made out of block board conforming IS 1659:2019 or latest (MR grade) of uniform thickness 19 mm.

The clear internal dimensions of block board cases should be as follows:

S. No.	Length (mm)	Width (mm)	Height (mm)
1.	670	620	270

NOTE: -

1. The quantity can be altered by $\pm 5\%$, The revised quantity will be intimated in due course

2. The following tolerances shall be permissible with respect to dimensions of the packing cases:

- a. Thickness of the block-board : + 1.0 mm
- b. Inner Height of the box : + 1.0 mm
- c. Inner Width and length : + 5.0 mm

3. Box will be made of 6 pieces and none of the six block board pieces used for the assembly of the boxes should have any joints on the surface as the boxes will be used for packing the currency notes.

4. Boxes should be supplied as per enclosed drawing no. BNP/C/0030R-1.

5. Five layered block board of well-seasoned good quality wood, used for commercial packing boxes, shall be used consisting of top & bottom face veneers 0.8 to 1 mm thickness & top and bottom core veneers of 2 to 2.5 mm thickness and the center core battens of Hard Wood with required thickness to maintain uniform overall thickness of 19 mm block board. The battens used for making of block board should not have any joints, knots, cracks or any other wood defects.



6. The center core battens of the block board should be softwood or medium density wood with minimum (14mm±0.5mm) thickness, width of 30mm ±1mm and 270 mm length) joined together in staggered formation.
7. All layers should be well seasoned & well bonded with BWR/MR grade adhesive conforming to IS 848:1974 or latest. There should not be any gap between the battens used in the block board.
8. Nails of size of 50 mm x 12 SWG with washers should be used for assembling the boxes at a distance of 50 mm.
9. The ends of top & bottom sides of the boards should remain slightly elevated as shown in the assembled view of the drawing, so that the top & bottom lids can be flushed in side to make the level remain uniform all the sides.
10. Boxes should be of sufficient mechanical strength & shall be able to carry & withstand maximum product weight of 150 Kilogram under jerks & rough handling during loading & unloading in Treasury van. These will be stacked six high one over the other in the treasury.
11. The nailed & strapped box should not get opened or de-shaped while dropping from a height 10 feet with 150 kg maximum load. The supplied boxes would be tested random basis.
12. Urea formaldehyde or phenol formaldehyde which is plastic resin will be used to attach the slice under high pressure.
13. The material used for preparing block board should be termite proof which is chemically treated during manufacturing to resist termites & borers. It shall be free from decay / insect attack / warping or any other defect, which may reduce the strength, life and usefulness of the packing case. The supplier has to submit a **'Declaration-cum-Undertaking regarding Chemical Treatment of Block Boards used for making Boxes'** in letterhead of the Company with each delivery. (Annexure - 1)
14. Each box should be stamped with following details:
Prefix (on the top side of the box)
General Manager, RBI (on the top side of the box)
WT. Kgs. (on the top side of the box) (Drawing attached)

TERMS & CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

1. The box should be delivered in complete assembled condition leaving the top lid open.



2. Under any circumstances, the buyer will not provide any space to the supplier for assembling of boxes at their premises. All assembly and related activities shall be completed by the supplier prior to delivery.
3. Each box should be stamped indicating the supplier's name in bold letters.
4. The Supplier must provide latest test certificate from a Govt. Approved laboratory/NABL accredited that the block board used for making the boxes is conforming to IS 1659:2019 or latest (MR Grade). The test certificate will be supplied along with pilot sample by the firm. The purchaser shall reserve the right to draw samples from any supplied lot at any stage during contract period and direct the supplier to have the sample tested at a NABL-accredited lab/ Govt. Approved laboratory at the supplier cost.
5. The supplier has to submit a declaration-cum-undertaking regarding confirming all the specification during bulk supply of boxes, in letter head of the Company. The above declaration to be submitted by the firm with each lot of Block Board Boxes.

6. The boxes should be neat, clean, & uniform in dimension & as per specification. The successful firm has to supply boxes as per delivery schedule. In event of random check of block board boxes on machine or in production area, if any box found damaged or deviating from specification, then the same will be rejected. The supplier firm will have to pick the rejected boxes from BNP and replace it by good boxes at his own risk and cost.
7. Inspection will be carried out at Bank Note Press Dewas. In the event of rejection of supplied boxes, if the firm desires to have joint inspection at BNP, then the said request should be sent within 20 days of the issue of intimation by rejection note sent. After that no claim whatsoever will be entertained.
8. The supplier has to pick the rejected box at his own risk and cost within 30 days after the issue of intimation by rejection note sent. After then, BNP will not liable for providing the rejected boxes.
9. The boxes should be supplied according to delivery schedule furnished along with the purchase order. The delivery schedule is subject to modification depending upon our requirement and your performance to deliver in time.
10. The Supplier will be responsible for obtaining clearance /permission or complete formalities required to be completed with the concerned state Govt, for the supplies in connection with the tendered quantity. BNP will not hold itself responsible



for any litigation in this respect.

11. Boxes will be made as per technical specification made in & Drwg. No. BNP/C/0030R1.

12. Payments terms as per condition of contract are acceptable.

13. Copy of supply order/bills of previous supplies made is enclosed.

14. The successful bidder will have to submit 03 no. of completely assembled box confirming to the specifications as representative sample before executing the bulk supply within 15 days of GEM contract.

15. **Warranty:** The items should be warranted against defects in material, design, workmanship etc. for a period of 12 months from the date of supply and acceptance. During warranty period the item should be repaired/replaced free of cost at our Press. If the boxes are found defective at a later stage (i.e. in Transit or end user's place etc.) even after delivery at BNP,Dewas but within the Warranty period, the supplier is liable to pay penalty equivalent value for that many numbers of damaged boxes as per Order value to safeguard the interests of BNP,Dewas.

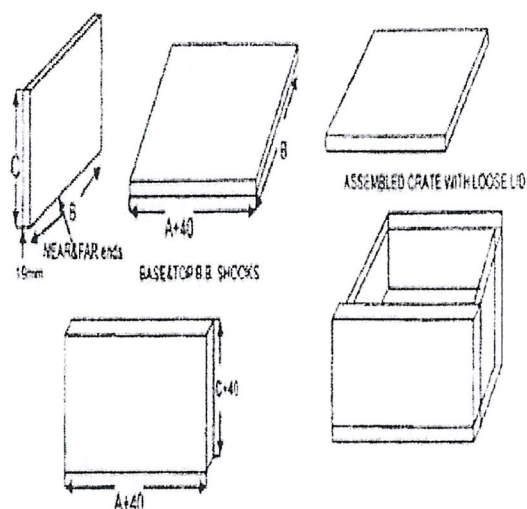

The packing cases of size as mentioned below shall be made out of block board conforming IS 1659:2019 or latest (MR grade) of uniform thickness 19 mm.

The clear internal dimensions of block board cases should be as follows:

2. The following tolerances shall be permissible with respect to dimensions of the packing cases:
 - a. Thickness of the block-board : + 1.0 mm
 - b. Inner Height of the box : + 1.0 mm
 - c. Inner Width and length : + 5.0 mm
3. Box will be made of 6 pieces and none of the six block board pieces used for the assembly of the boxes should have any joints on the surface as the boxes will be used for packing the currency notes.
4. Boxes should be supplied as per enclosed drawing no. BNP/C/0030R-1.
5. Five layered block board of well-seasoned good quality wood, used for commercial packing boxes, shall be used consisting of top & bottom face veneers 0.8 to 1 mm thickness & top and bottom core veneers of 2 to 2.5 mm thickness and the center core battens of Hard Wood with required thickness to maintain uniform overall thickness of 19 mm block board. 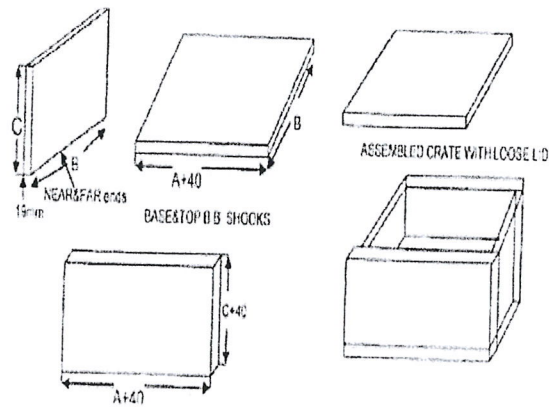
